

Instructions on how to set up users (learners/teachers) when using the application on a tablet.

1st step: Download the application for mobile apps using the AppStore for IOS or the GooglePlay for Android.

This link provides details for installing the mobile app on a phone or tablet. The application requires an active user account and works exclusively with Open eClass sites that have enabled the mobile API. Once the app is installed, users need to enter the following details:

- The URL of the eClass platform (in this case: <https://skillsforcloud.com/eclass>)
- Their existing username and password.

Attached, you will find screenshots of the mobile app interface to help visualize the navigation and features of the application.

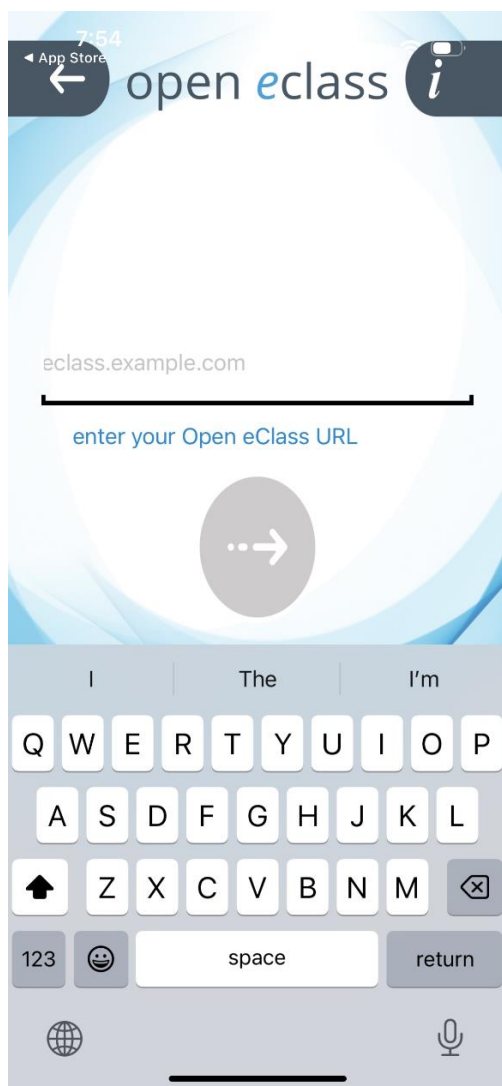


Figure 1. Mobile app login page

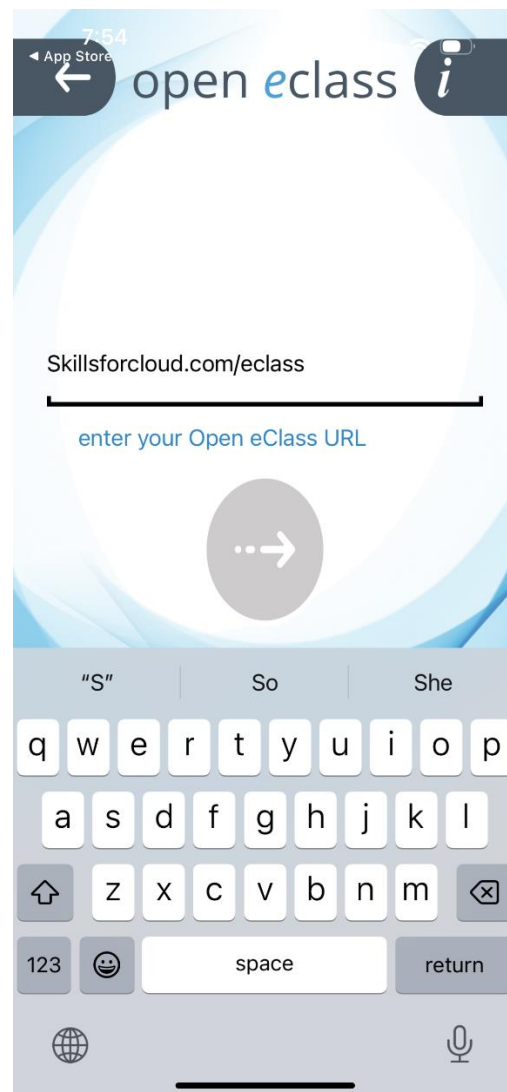


Figure 2. Fill with the URL of the eclass

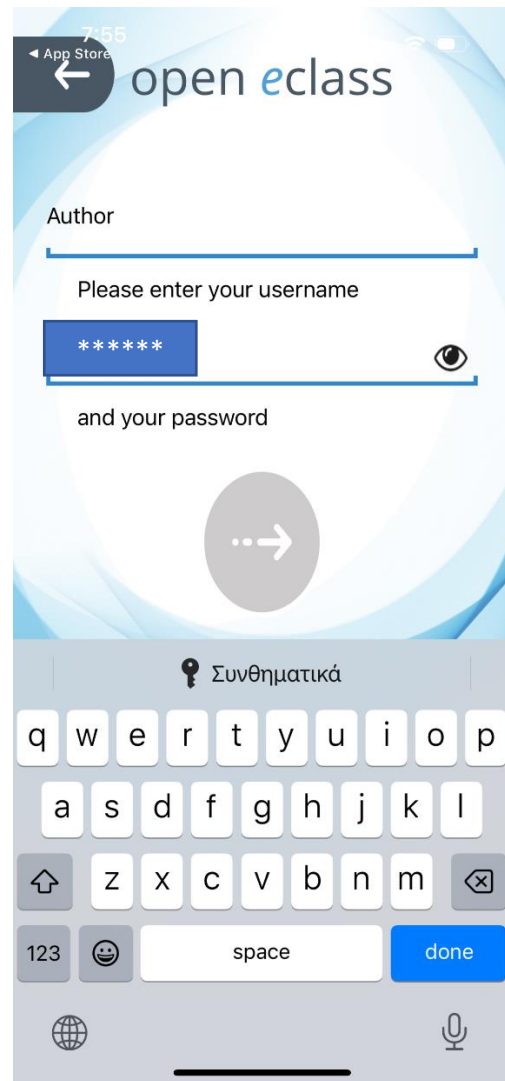


Figure 4. For a lecturer use Author and ######

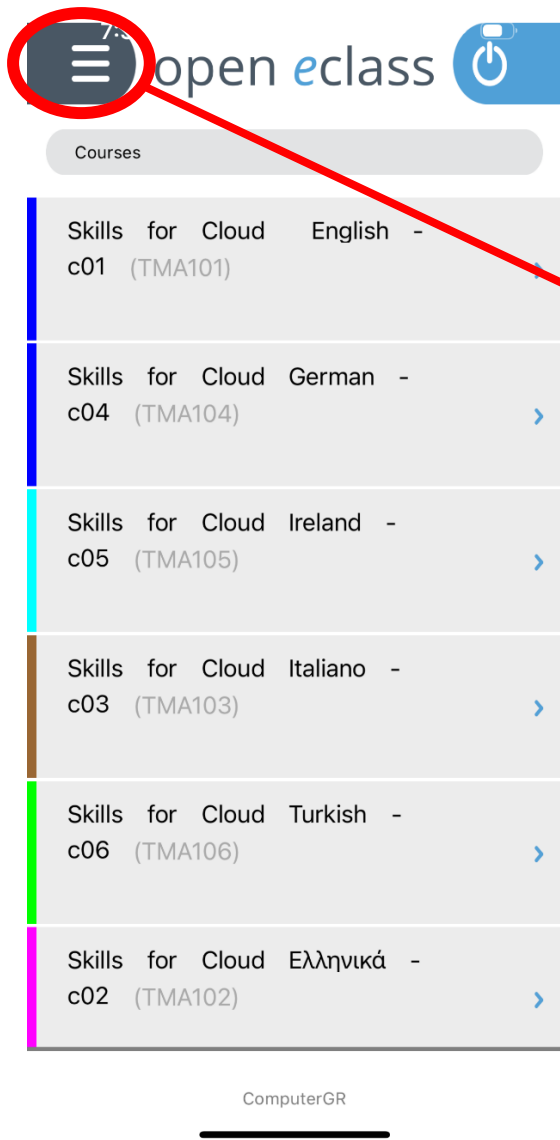


Figure 5. The Skills Cloud courses and the menu

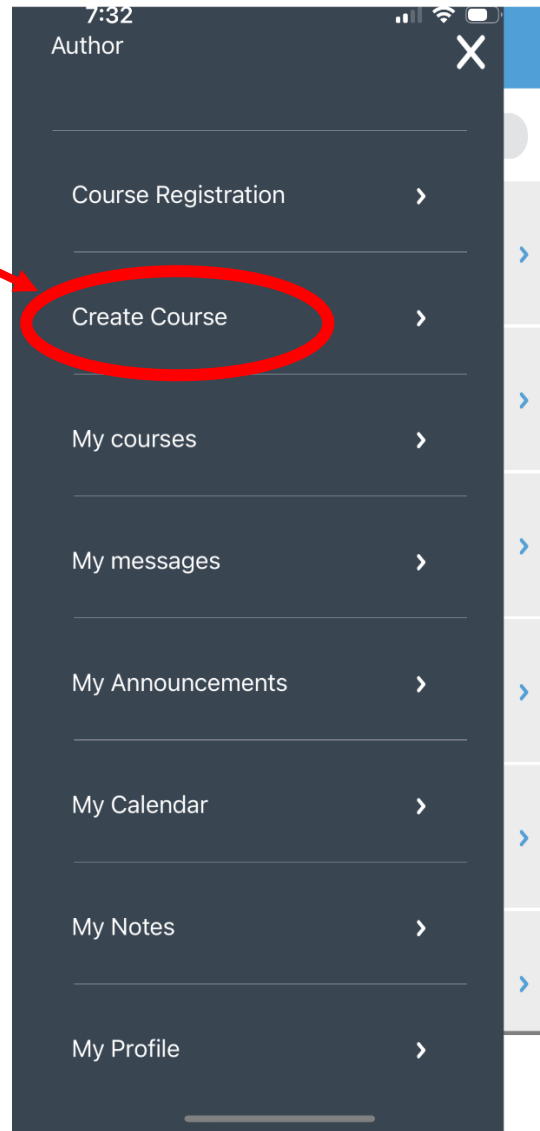


Figure 6. Create new course

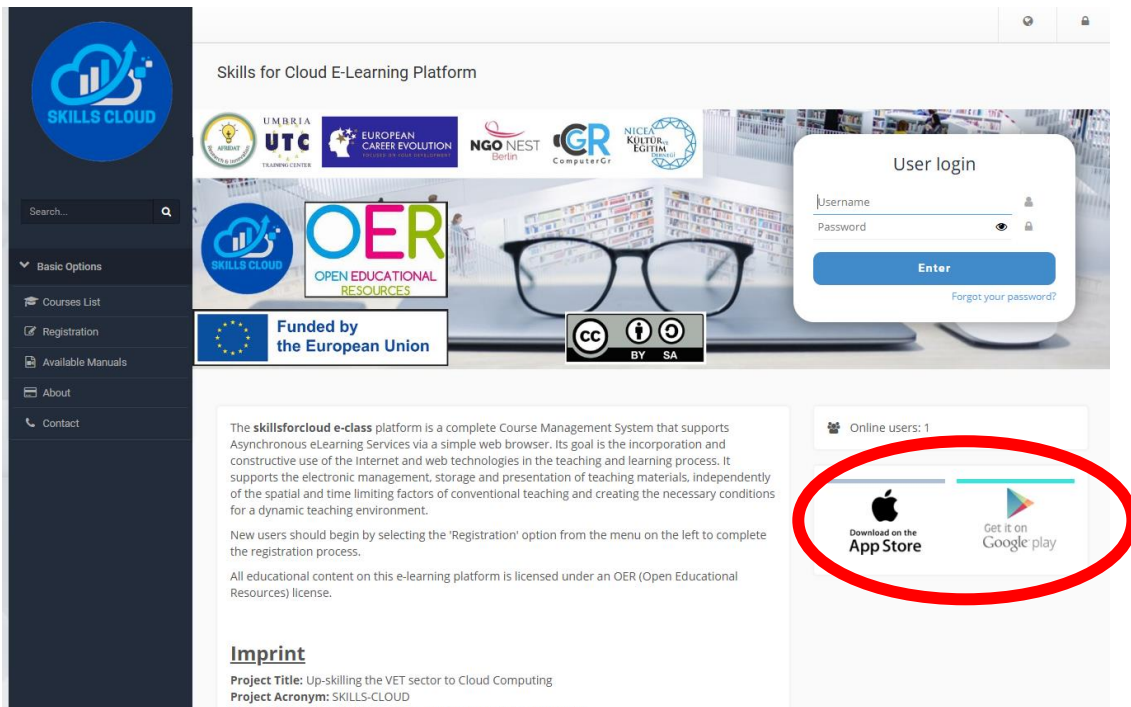


Figure 9. The links for downloading the mobile apps with AppStore for IOS or with GooglePlay for Android

If a teacher at a vocational school wants to prepare a class for these courses, they must register as a teacher on the platform. The platform administrator will then grant them access to all the courses as a lecturer. Students must also register for a specific course, and an email will be automatically sent to their personal address to confirm their registration. Once registered, students or teachers can access the courses via the mobile application on iOS or Android.
